In a recent decision by DCAS, Hudson Elevator Group was awarded, as the lowest responsible bidder, the modernization of ten traction elevators at the historic 80 Centre Street building in Civic Center, downtown Manhattan.

The modernization is unique in the fact that Hudson Elevator Group will also be the General Contractor, coordinating all construction work on the job, including; electrical upgrades, roof replacement, asbestos abatement, window replacement, plumbing and HVAC.

The elevator modernization is for 10

Elevators, 9 stops, 8 Gearless and 2 Geared. Only the rails and frames are being retained. The rest of the scope consists of new machines, platforms, cabs and fixtures.

80 Centre Street is part of the civil division of the New York County Supreme Court. Built in 1929, the original elevators are still in operation.

Hudson has taken over interim maintenance on the existing, original elevators and will continue to maintain the elevators under a one year contract warranty period as part of the modernization contract.
